This equipment can only be used in training and competition for MRA identified athletes through the Manitoba Rowing Association Tier System (see document Tier System Outline) and/or as determined by the VP High Performance and the Provincial Head Coach. The intent is to allow high performance athletes and crews the ability to train and race in appropriate equipment while under the direction of the Provincial Head Coach and any other coaches assigned to assist with the provincial team.

The MRA Board will consider exceptions to the policy only if there is an obvious benefit to the High Performance program (i.e. Rental of equipment at regattas e.g. World Masters) where revenue generated can be applied to maintenance, repair or acquisition of equipment. The MRA will also consider exceptions to the policy with regards to adaptive equipment use.
