



## **PETER NYKOLUK ROWING SCHOLARSHIP**

**A financial award** in memory of Peter is available annually to recognize athletes who are striving for excellence in rowing and are making an outstanding contribution to the sport. The recipients will share many of the same values of determination, commitment and sportsmanship consistently displayed by Peter.

**The purpose is** to assist athletes fulfill their educational goals while participating in the sport. One must be enrolled as a full-time student at a Community College or University in Manitoba and have achieved a satisfactory academic standing.

**The award will be up to \$15,000** depending on the number of finalists. All eligible students are encouraged to apply.

## **PETER NYKOLUK ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP**

**Purpose:** An entrance scholarship of \$1000 is available to assist and encourage post-secondary students to participate in the sport of rowing for the first time by providing financial assistance to meet some of the costs of becoming a member of the Winnipeg Rowing Club. One must be enrolled or accepted as a full-time student (minimum 18 credit hours or equivalent) at a community college or university in Manitoba and achieved a satisfactory academic standing.

Up to five \$1000 awards are available to eligible applicants.
